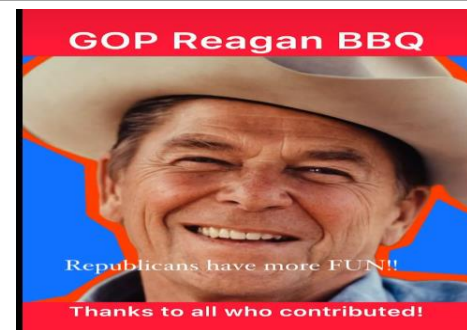

Some of you may be surprised what has been added to their policy without your knowledge. Are they allowing all genders to participate in single gender sports? Are they speaking about “pronouns” used by the students? Are they allowing teachers/administrators to determine the maturity level of the student before speaking about gender reassignment and LGBTQ+++? Who is permitted in locker rooms? What books are in your schools’ library? Do your research before you vote. Your tax dollars may be going towards funding for programs and items you do not approve of.

NOVEMBER 7, 2023 – PROPOSED “REPRODUCTION RIGHTS” AMENDMENT

FULL TEXT OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Be it Resolved by the People of the State of Ohio that Article I of the Ohio Constitution is amended to add the following Section:

Article I, Section 22. The Right to Reproductive Freedom with Protections for Health and Safety

A. Every individual has a right to make and carry out one's own reproductive decisions, including but not limited to decisions on:

1. contraception;
2. fertility treatment;
3. continuing one's own pregnancy;
4. miscarriage care; and
5. abortion.

B. The State shall not, directly or indirectly, burden, penalize, prohibit, interfere with, or discriminate against either:

1. An individual's voluntary exercise of this right or
2. A person or entity that assists an individual exercising this right,

unless the State demonstrates that it is using the least restrictive means to advance the individual's health in accordance with widely accepted and evidence-based standards of care.

However, abortion may be prohibited after fetal viability. But in no case may such an abortion be prohibited if in the professional judgment of the pregnant patient's treating physician it is necessary to protect the pregnant patient's life or health.

C. As used in this Section:

1. "Fetal viability" means "the point in a pregnancy when, in the professional judgment of the pregnant patient's treating physician, the fetus has a significant likelihood of survival outside the uterus with reasonable measures. This is determined on a case-by-case basis."
2. "State" includes any governmental entity and any political subdivision.

D. This Section is self-executing.

The word "woman" does not appear in this entire amendment

FULL TEXT OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Be it Resolved by the People of the State of Ohio that Article I of the Ohio Constitution is amended to add the following Section:

Article I, Section 22. The Right to Reproductive Freedom with Protections for Health and Safety (mostly for abortion providers)

A. Every individual has a right to (make and carry out) one's own reproductive decisions, including but not limited to decisions on:

- 1. contraception;
- 2. fertility treatment;
- 3. continuing one's own pregnancy;
- 4. miscarriage care; and
- 5. abortion. → throughout all nine months

any age including minors
not gender specific
without limits
gender selection
abortion harvesting
body parts
chemical castration
trans surgeries on minors
cloning
no parental consent for minors

B. The State shall not, directly or indirectly, burden, penalize, prohibit, interfere with, or discriminate against either:

1. An individual's voluntary exercise of this right or
2. A person or entity that assists an individual exercising this right,
→ includes group/activists in schools instructing minors on sexual practices

FINAL THOUGHT

The Ohio Legislature will have NO power to mitigate against the abuse of this language, because this is a Constitutional right. Thus, the people of Ohio will be silenced on this subject.
