





Right vs. Privilege

In Ohio currently, hunting and fishing is a privilege that can be revoked at any time. Harvesting wildlife is a valued part of Ohio's heritage. By making these foundational activities a part of the Ohio Constitution, this legislation will assert them as a fundamental right to all Ohioans and will forever preserve them for the good of the public.



Constitutional Amendment

It will be up to the people of Ohio to decide whether to ensure these rights are a part of Ohio's Constitution. All constitutional amendments must be voted on by the people and passed by a majority of 50% plus one vote.



General Assembly

If passed, it will be the sole responsibility of the General Assembly to enact laws concerning or promoting the conservation and management of wildlife and the preservation of the future of hunting and fishing.



Property Rights

This amendment will not impact the rights of landowners. All state laws pertaining to the rights of landowners and trespassing will not change with this constitutional amendment. Land that has traditionally been open to hunting and fishing will remain open for these sports.



Sportsmen Feeling the Squeeze

With increasing urbanization, decreased habitat, declining numbers of sportsmen these havens of wildlife are quickly dwindling. This constitutional amendment will help preserve these areas and protect the heritage of Ohio.

Updates on the Ohio Capital Budget and Trumbull County

COLUMBUS – State Representative Mike Loychik (R-Bazetta) is pleased to provide an update on the Capital Budget process within the Ohio House of Representatives, and the positive impact it will have on Trumbull County.

"I am proud to work for the people of the 65th House District each and every day in Columbus. The Capital Budget is another opportunity to invest in our critical infrastructure, our workforce development, and most importantly our people. We are putting Ohio workers and families first, so they can succeed and thrive for the long term."

A total of nearly \$10 million in funding is being sought for Trumbull County, with top priority given to the following projects:

- Eastern Ohio Biztown Financial Literacy & Entrepreneurship Center: expanding hands-on financial literacy and entrepreneurship education programming.
- Brookfield Regional Workforce Training & Community Wellness Center: state-of-the art facility that will enhance industry-aligned training and overall wellness.
- The Western Reserve Port Authority: establishing an Aviation Education Center at the Youngstown-Warren Regional Airport for commercial pilot and mechanical training.
- Mosquito Creek Lake State Park Water Improvements: protecting local economies and ecosystems by increasing the chemical mitigation against hydrilla.
- Trumbull County Fairgrounds: renovating the grandstands to increase its life by 40 years.

The Capital Budget is under further consideration by both chambers of the Ohio Legislature prior to its passage this spring. The Representative will continue to be a strong advocate for the district through his work on the House Finance Committee.

Auditor of State's Special Investigations Unit Seeking Information on Potential Wrongdoing at Eastern Gateway Community College

COLUMBUS – The Auditor of State's Special Investigations Unit (SIU) is seeking information on potential fraud, waste, and abuse of public resources at Eastern Gateway Community College.

SIU recently established a dedicated email address (<u>SIUEGCC@ohioauditor.gov</u>) for tips from anyone who suspects wrongdoing. Individuals also can submit information, confidentially if desired, through SIU's webpage (https://ohioauditor.gov/fraud/default.html) or the Auditor of State's Fraud Hotline, 866-FRAUD-OH (866-372-8364).

On Jan. 4, SIU, along with the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office, the Ohio State Highway Patrol's Computer Crimes Unit, the U.S. Secret Service, the Coumbus Division of Police's Digital Forensics Unit, and the Ohio Narcotics Intelligence Center, executed a search warrant related to ongoing investigations concerning Eastern Gateway Community College.

Since 2019, the Special Investigations Unit has assisted in 117 convictions resulting in more than \$8.2 million in restitution (see <u>Map of SIU Convictions</u> since January 2019). The team receives hundreds of tips of suspected fraud annually. Tips can be submitted anonymously online or via SIU's fraud hotline at 866-FRAUD-OH (866-372-8364).

The Auditor of State's Office, one of five independently elected statewide offices in Ohio is responsible for auditing more than 5,900 state and local government agencies. Under the direction of Auditor Keith Faber, the office also provides financial services to local governments, investigates and prevents fraud in public agencies, and promotes transparency in government.

REPUBLICAN GOVERNORS BAND TOGETHER, ISSUE JOINT STATEMENT SUPPORTING TEXAS' CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHT TO SELF-DEFENSE



January 25, 2024

WASHINGTON, D.C. – 25 Republican governors released the following joint statement in support of Texas Governor Greg Abbott and Texas' constitutional right to self-defense.

The statement comes as the Biden Administration continues to attack Texas and refuses to take action or responsibility for the crisis at the Southern border.

"President Biden and his Administration have left Americans and our country completely vulnerable to unprecedented illegal immigration pouring across the Southern border. Instead of upholding the rule of law and securing the border, the Biden Administration has attacked and sued Texas for stepping up to protect American citizens from historic levels of illegal immigrants, deadly drugs like fentanyl, and terrorists entering our country.

"We stand in solidarity with our fellow Governor, Greg Abbott, and the State of Texas in utilizing every tool and strategy, including razor wire fences, to secure the border. We do it in part because the Biden Administration is refusing to enforce immigration laws already on the books and is illegally allowing mass parole across America of migrants who entered our country illegally.

"The authors of the U.S. Constitution made clear that in times like this, states have a right of self-defense, under Article 4, Section 4 and Article 1, Section 10, Clause 3 of the U.S. Constitution. Because the Biden Administration has abdicated its constitutional compact duties to the states, Texas has every legal justification to protect the sovereignty of our states and our nation."

The letter states that the Biden Administration's mandates are unrealistic, costly, and prescriptive solutions that harm American consumers.
